**City Sticker and Residential Parking Permit Enforcement
Suspended and Will Not Begin Until August 1, 2010**
Traditionally, Enforcement for New Sticker Begins July 15th

Parking ticket enforcement for vehicle stickers ("City stickers") and residential parking permits has been suspended and will not begin until August 1st. The extension for the purchase and display of the City's vehicle sticker was recently announced by the Office of the City Clerk to provide ample time for motorists who unfortunately received some defective stickers with little or no adhesive to replace those stickers free of charge.

The Office of the City Clerk announced the revised enforcement date noting that stickers must be purchased and displayed before the end of the month. To avoid any motorist being issued a ticket through no fault of his or her own, parking enforcement Citywide for all vehicle sticker and residential permit parking will be suspended until August 1, including enforcement for missing or expired stickers.

Residential parking permit enforcement is also being suspended until August 1 because the annual permits are purchased as combined stickers with the City's vehicle sticker. As always, any motorist who is issued a ticket in error should call 312.744.PARK (7275) or 311.

Motorists who have already purchased a city sticker, and have not yet placed it on their vehicle windshield are encouraged to check that the adhesive is adequate.

Motorists who received a defective 2010-2011 vehicle sticker can contact the Office of the City Clerk by e-mail at cityclerk@cityofchicago.org or by calling 312.742.9200 to receive a free replacement in the mail. Motorists can also mail a defective sticker to the following address to receive a free replacement in the mail.
